## Lok Adalat Visit (8<sup>th</sup> April, 2017)

As part of the clinical activity, the students of BALLB visited the Lok Adalat held at District Court, Surajpur, Greater Noida on 8th of April 2017. The Lok-Adalats are formal bodies set up under the state, but following the Alternative Dispute Resolution method to settle petty disputes that do not require any elaborate enquiry or evidentiary process.

The students witnessed the disposition of cases at the Lok-Adalat to get a first-hand account of legal proceedings.



## Parliament Visit (13<sup>th</sup> April, 2017)

Innovative Institute of Law, organised a visit to the Parliament of India, the federal legislative body of the Republic of India, on April 13, 2017 to make the law students understand the importance of the Parliament and its functions. The students visited the Rajya Sabha, the Lok Sabha and the Central Hall and also got the opportunity to interact with the officials of the Parliament.

## Dental Checkup (1st May, 2017)

A free dental checkup and awareness camp was organized at the premises of Innovative Institute of Law. A team of Senior Specialist Dental Surgeons and para-medical staff carried out a comprehensive dental checkup on students. The students got ample opportunities to interact with the dental surgeons to enquire and gain knowledge concerning oral diseases.
